164											796: following the assassination of King Aethelred (Etheled) was the 27 day		
165											reign of the Patrician, King Osbald, after which he took flight, presumably for		
166											his own safety (a &c). Soon after "Heardulf [Eardulf] was called from exile" being "invested		
167											with regal dignity, ...being consecrated at the altar of St Paul in the church of		
168											St Peter at York by the northern Archbishop Eanbald, assisted by Bishops Ethelberht,		
169											Higbald and Badewulf, Bishop of Hexham, Lindisfarne and Whithern, on vii kal. June 796" (c,e).		
170											796: According to Simeon of Durham, "Eardwulf was consecrated King of Northumbria at York" at		
171											the church of St Peter, before the altar of the apostle Paul. In the same year Archbishop Eanbald		
172											died and was buried in the church of St Peter. The detail of Eardwulf's consecration suggests the		
173											compiler of the Northumbrian Chronicle writing in the early 9th Century and possibly as early		
174											as 806 got his information from an 'eye-witness' or was perhaps present himself.		
175											The impression is that Eardwulf at his accession was thoroughly acceptable to the church was		
176											not so universally popular among the lay nobility. Eardwulf met & countered a succession		
177											of threats from rivals in the first years of his reign (f).		
178											797: Alcuin was not wholly enamoured by Eardwulf however he showed concern for Eardwulf's		
179											safety as early as 796 when he warned him that his personal sins could lose him his kingdom.		
180											Specifically relevant was adultery for according to Alcuin, Eardwulf had dismissed his wife and		
181											publically taken a concubine. Eardwulf's adultery was potentially serious because he became		
182											estranged from Eanbald II, Archbishop of York (f).		
183											798: The murderers of Etheled conspired against their former idol, Eardulf. In the second year of		
184											his reign, the King [Eardulf] met the rebels and after a severe contest and considerable slaughter		
185											on both sides the royal army was victorious and the insurgent leader, Wada (Wade), was obliged		
186											to fly (c, e). The battle was on Billington Moor, near Whalley in Lancashire on April 2, 798 (f).		
187											Two events stain the government of Eardulf, but were in accordance with the character of the times.		
188											One was the death of Moll (Ethelwald ?) in 799. The other was the massacre of Ealhmund		
189											(Alcumund) in 800 who was siezed and put to death in 800 (c, f).		
190											For the future security of his crown and in line with the barbarous ideas of security which		
191											prevailed at the time, Eardulf put to death Alchmund, the son of Alered through who the ancient		
192											race of the Northumbrian Kings was wholly extinguished (e)		
193											In 801 Eardulf turned his arms against Kenulf of Mercia who had been protecting some of his		
194											enemies. Kenulf soon raised an army and was quickly in the field meeting Eardulf's hostilities		
195											with equal alacrity. The clergy however interferred and with their advise a reconciliation was		
196											effected with peace agreed upon by both sides (c).		
197											In 806 Eardulf was deserted by his subjects and banished from the Kingdom (c). He was expelled		
198											by Aelfwald II (Alfwold) who then reigned from 806-808 (f).		
199											The community of St Cuthberts preserved isolated details about Northumbrian Kings.		
200											The early 9th C. saw temporary restoration of political stability. Eardulf lost his throne		
201											in 806. The expulsion is recorded in the 'Anglo-Saxon Chronicle' (b). He regained his throne		
202											in 809 through the intervention of Charlemaine, his restoration being recorded in the		
203											'Frankish Annals'. It appears that rather than by armed force, he was reinstated by diplomatic		
204											pressure alone, through a small number of emmionaries from Charlemagne and the Pope (b).		
205											808-811/2: According to 'Kirby' (f) Eardwulf visited Charlemagne & Pope Leo III and he suggests		
206											that Eardwulf was escorted back by imperial and papal envoys & re-established in his kingdom		
207											in 808 & may have reigned a further 3 years before passing the kingship to his son Eanred (f).		
208											Note: Archaeologists found coins at Hexham bearing Eardulf's name (d).		
209											He was the first Northumbrian king to pass the kingship		
210											peacefully to his son (Eanfrid) for over 100 years (a).		
211											Despite his troubles during his reign Eardwulf created a resilient		
212											enough power-base for his son and grandson to effectively		
213											dominate the Northumbrian kingship across the first		
214											half of the 9thC in relative peace (f).
