Robert de Brus
Came from Normandy with William the Conqueror and became an opulent Baron in Yorkshire

Robert Brus
He was in the court of Henry I of Scotland with Earl David. After the assession of David in 1124 he was granted the lands of Annandale. He also held Gyseburn where he died d: 1141

Adam Brus
He inherited the English estates and was progenitor of the Bruces of Skelton

Robert Brus
He inherited Annandale in 1171. He flourished under David I, Malcolm IV and William the Lion of Scotland
= Euphemia

Robert BRUS
of Annandale and Gyseburn, Scotland (d: <1190)
1 = **ISABELLA**
Daughter of William the Lion
2 = **Robert de Ros**

under Alexander II of Scotland d: 1245
Buried in the Abbey of Saltre, near Stilton, built by the 2nd Simon st Liz, Earl of Huntingdon and Northampton
= **Isabel**
2nd Daughter of David, Earl of Huntingdon
d: 1251

ROBERT BRUCE
Lord of Annandale under Alexander III. In 1255 he was one of 15 Regents who contended for the Crown
d: 1295
w: at Lochmaban Castle
= **Christian**
Daughter of Gilbert, Earl of Gloucester

ROBERT BRUCE

ROBERT BRUCE
Earl of Carrick, Lord of Annandale. Accompanied Edward I to Palestine in 1269
m: 1271
d: 1304

Countess of Carrick
d: 1292

ROBERT BRUCE
b: 1274 (eldest son)
1296: Swore fealty to Edward I.
Was one of 15 Guardians of Scotland for Edward Baliol; others included the Bishop of St Andrews and John Cumyn (the younger)
1306, Feb. 10: Slew John Cumyn.
1306-1329: King of Scotland

d: 1316
= **Walter**
The Stewart of Scotland
d: 1326

ROBERT STEWART II
b: 1315/6, Mar. 2
1371-1390: King of Scotland
1 = **Elizabeth MOORE**
2 = **Euphemia ROS**
Daughter of the Earl of Ros

JOHN STEWART
(eldest child)
1390-1406: King of Scotland - known as **ROBERT II**
(1402: Battle of Homildon)

Duke of Rothsay
Castle of Rothsay in Bute, Scotland
He was murdered

of Scotland
= **Archibald DOUGLAS**
4th Earl of Douglas

Killed near Dunbalk, Scotland

DAVID II BRUCE
b: 1323/4
1329-1371: King of Scotland
= **Jojanna (Joan)**
Daughter of Edward II of England

ROBERT STEWART
Earl of Fife, Duke of Albany.
Governor of the Kingdom in his fathers later life
1406-1419: Regent for Scotland

1419: Regent for Scotland

THOMAS BRUCE

ALEXANDER BRUCE

Both Thomas and Alexander were taken prisoner in Galloway in 1307, Feb. 9 and put to death at Carlisle by Edward I

NIGEL BRUCE

d: 1306
He was taken at Kildrummie and put to death at Berwick.

1 = **The Dauphine of France**
2 = **Darnley**
3 = **Bothwell**

Earl of Arran
Great-grandson of Mary Stewart
Regent of James V and of Mary

JAMES STEWART VI & I
James VI, King of Scotland and James I, King of England
King 1567 - 1625
= **Anne of Denmark**
