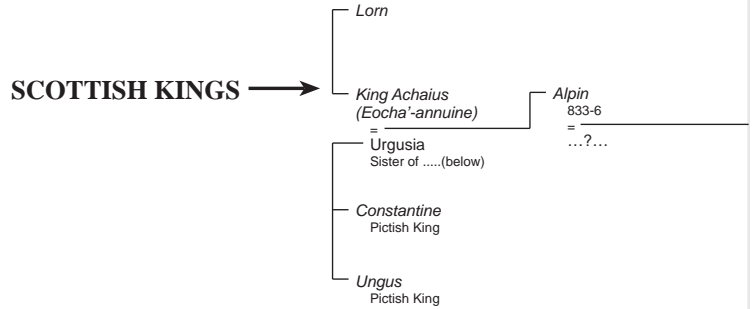


# SWINTON: Chart 1C, Sheet 1

Descent of the Swinton Family from their earliest Edulfing Family ancestors.  
 The descent of the Scottish and English Kings is shown as in real terms the Edulfing/Swinton Family was located between the two. These royal lines also show which Kings held influence over the family through their history.  
 Their inclusion also enables royal blood-lines to be shown between the kingdoms.

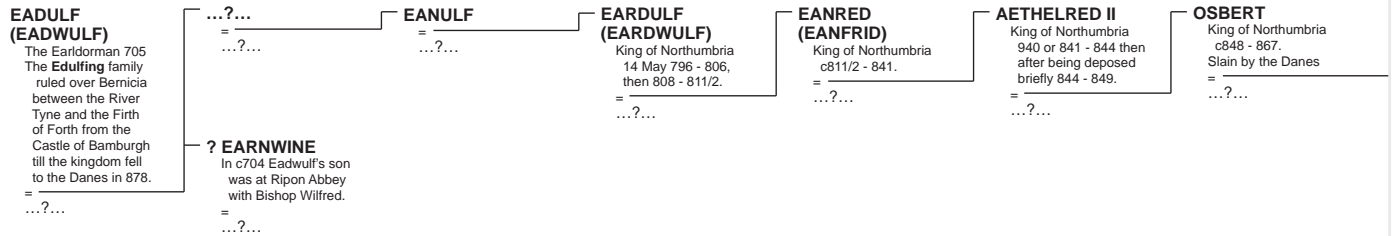

## THE EDULFING / SWINTON FAMILY

The "Eadulfings" are reputed to have descended from *Ida* 'the flamebearer' who became Overking of Bernicia in 547 and made his fortress stronghold at *Din Guayrði*, later called *Bamburgh Castle*. *Ida*, claimed to be the 9th descendant of the Angle god, 'Woden'. He had 12 sons, 6 by his wife Bearnoch, and 6 by concubines. From which of these sons Eadulf descended is yet to be discovered.
